The following guidelines have been developed in coordination with MHSAA rules and regulations and other schools in our league. Some specific guidelines will differ from school to school based on space or size, but we are working together to follow the same intention of the rules. We are working to provide as many opportunities as possible, while still meeting the guidelines from the MHSAA and State of Michigan. Per our governor, we are bound by the MHSAA's guidelines.

Under current guidelines by the MHSAA, we may play!!!!!!!!!!!!!! However, there are a few guidelines that need to be followed. Read the guidelines below and PLEASE follow them. Whether or not we agree with them or think that they are necessary is not the point. We are called to obey. This is a wonderful opportunity to lead by example and teach our children proper adherence to the Fifth Commandment. Through this we bring glory to our great God! Thank you for helping to make this a safe and successful sports season!

Masks:

- Will be worn by coaches and administrators at all times. During practices and games.
- Will be worn by athletes at all times. During practices and games. There are no provisions for medical intolerance reasons or medical waivers.
- Will be worn by officials when not officiating the game. It is not required for an official when carrying out his duties.
- Will be worn by spectators at all times. Whether the game is inside or outside doesn't matter.
- Will be worn by athletes and drivers while being transported to games when carpooling. If you choose to drive your child to the game a mask does not need to be worn in the car. As soon as another athlete joins the vehicle, a mask will need to be worn by all in the vehicle.

Health:

- The same health screening that is done at the beginning of the school day will apply to athletes attending practice or games. ACS will not screen between the end of the school day and beginning of practice.

Cleaning/Hygiene:

- Shared equipment will be cleaned as often as possible.
- Coaches will have hand sanitizer at practices and games for athletes.

- ACS will make hand sanitizer available to spectators as they enter the gym.
- Players need to bring and use their own water bottles.

Spectators:

- For both volleyball and soccer, **each participant is allowed two guests only.**
- Younger siblings may not stay and wait at school for games to begin.
- Children count towards the spectator limit and may not be loose in the school building during games.

Entrances & Exits:

- Each school will have an entrance and exit plan to prevent congestion and crowding. This will be communicated before any away games.
- When entering Adams Christian School for a home volleyball game, enter through Door B. This is the door by the south parking lot. Please exit this way as well.
- All away team visitors will enter and exit through Door C. This is the door by the library.

Positive COVID Cases:

- We will follow health department regulations on positive case contact notification. This includes communication between league athletic directors as necessary.
